20:00 VERLOREN HOEK - CARMERSTRAAT 178

Simple pub in a lost but picturesque corner of Bruges.

Normal draft lager at 1.90 euro (25cl). Other beers at 2.30 euro for 25cl or 3.30 for 33cl. Most soft drinks at 2 euro.

15 to 20 min. stroll along the mills on the “Vesten” while the sun sets over Bruges. We may take some extra time for Bart – our host - to name every tower of the city
